### **Second Harvest Food Drive Update**

The results are in from our incredibly successful food drive on behalf of Second Harvest of the Big Bend region. The collection ran from July 1 through August 15. Volunteers placed boxes in their offices, churches, and businesses. We collected 2,441 items, including:



- 1,366 cans of fruit and vegetables
- 348 boxes of macaroni and cheese, cereal, and pancake mix
- 291 packages of beans and pasta.

Weighing in at 2,267 pounds, we provided over a TON of food!

In addition to food items, we collected \$520 in cash donations. TEKSystems has offices throughout the panhandle and ran a competition between offices to collect monetary donations; they were able to present a giant check for \$500!

According to Second Harvest, this was the largest food drive donation received this summer and helped kick off their September Food for Forty food drive initiative.

Thank you to everyone who participated and helped give back to our community in such an important and meaningful way!
